*Longevity is admirable, but her legacy is her dedication to local community history!*

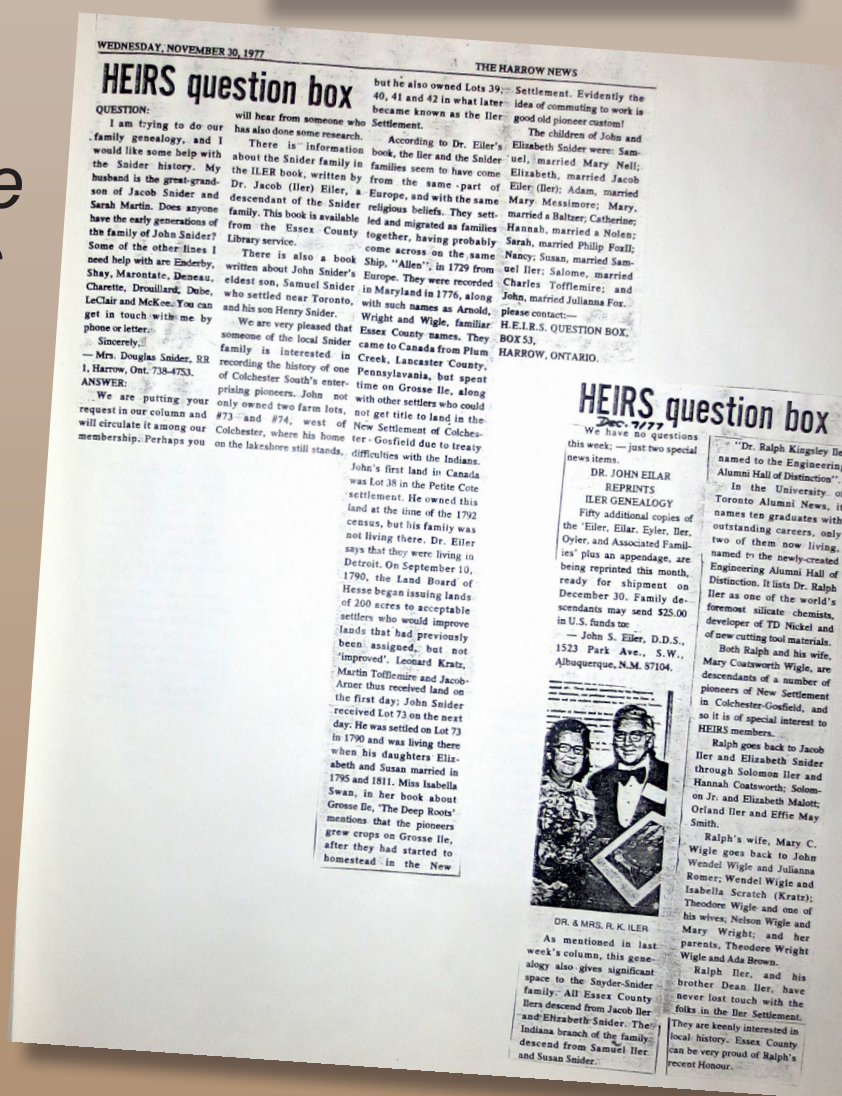
*Edith supported and motivated hundreds of people to fulfill their own family history quest. She authored and co-wrote several books and received community awards for her valuable contributions over five decades.*
